

2024 Franchising Economic Outlook

The 2024 Franchising Economic Outlook is IFA's annual study in partnership with FRANdata detailing the franchise sector's performance for the past year and projected economic outlook for the year ahead, as well as an in-depth state outlook for all 50 states and Washington, D.C. Franchising is one of the most successful business models in the United States, and that will not change in the years to come. However, franchising was not just about business in 2023 – it was about people too. The franchisors and their franchisees are the people who made this happen and continued to allow the industry to thrive.

Key highlights from the report include:

- The overall number of franchise establishments will increase by more than 15,000 units in 2024, or 1.9%, to 821,000 units in the U.S.
- Franchising will add approximately 221,000 jobs in 2024. Growing at 3.0%, total franchise employment is forecasted to reach 8.9 million.
- The total output of franchised businesses the measure of total economic activity in nominal dollars — will increase by 4.1% to \$893.9 billion in 2024, up from \$858.5 billion in 2023.
- Franchises' GDP will continue to grow, increasing at a pace of 4.3% to \$545.8 billion.
- Personal services and quick service restaurants (QSRs) will experience the strongest growth of any industry.
